Office of Sponsored Projects Annual Report Fiscal Year 1998 – 99

Highlights

UCSC's grants and contracts funding increased 7.8 percent from last year, 30 percent in the last five years and 255 percent in the last ten years.

During FY 1998 – 99 UCSC Principal Investigators (PIs) received 635 awards for a total of \$50,595,260, highest level in UCSC history; 78% of the PIs were tenure/tenure-track faculty and 22% were researchers.


Over two-thirds of funds came from the federal government. Second largest source of funds was non-governmental, followed by the State of California.


The single largest funding source was the National Science Foundation (\$9M), followed by the National Institutes of Health (\$7.6M). The single largest non-governmental funding source was the Packard Foundation (\$1.8M).

The top three campus units receiving awards were Biology (\$8.0M), Education (\$7.9M), and Institute of Marine Sciences (\$7.3M).

Awards from the private sector, accounting for 16% of total award dollars, increased two-fold from last year; awards from private businesses increased one-and-a-half times and grants from private foundations increased three-fold.

Over 700 proposals were submitted by 48 different campus units for a total value of \$146.6M.
