

# Office of Sponsored Projects Annual Report Fiscal Year 2001–2002

#### Highlights

- Grants and contracts awards (695) totaled \$67,956,919, a 5% dollar increase from last year; total awarded indirect costs increased 22%; recovered federal indirect costs increased 14% to \$7.7M.
- Externally funded direct expenditures contributed 23% of all campus expenditures under instruction, research and other academic programs.
- ★ Over 75% of awards were from federal government. Second largest fund source was private, followed by UC systemwide initiatives.
- ★ Single largest fund source was National Science Foundation (\$18.1M), followed by National Institutes of Health (\$13.1M). Single largest private fund source was David and Lucille Packard Foundation (\$1.9M).
- Top five campus units receiving awards were Institute of Marine Sciences (\$7.7M), UCO/Lick (\$7.3M), Molecular, Cell & Developmental Biology (\$6.7M), Chemistry (\$6.3M) and Earth Sciences (\$5.3M).
- Number of proposals submitted (960) increased 33%.



### UCSC Grants and Contracts by Sponsor Type: FY 2001–2002






