



Office of Sponsored Projects Annual Report Fiscal Year 2005–2006

Highlights

- Grants and contracts awards (894) totaled \$128,457,509, a 28% increase over last year—one of the fastest annual increases ever experienced by any UC campus.
- Recovered federal indirect costs were at an all-time high of \$13.3M; total awarded indirects, from all sources, increased 30% to another all-time high, \$22M.
- All campus divisions experienced growth and some units, for example, the Educational Partnership Center and The New Teacher Center, more than doubled over last year.
- Over last five years, UCSC has received almost one-half billion dollars in external funding.
- Externally funded direct expenditures contributed 33% of all campus expenditures under instruction, research and other academic programs.
- Over 79% of awards were from the federal government; second largest funding source was private foundations, followed by the State of California.
- The single-largest award, for \$23 million, went to the University Affiliated Research Center (UARC), located at the NASA Ames Research Center.
- The single-largest funding source was NASA (\$30.4M), followed by the National Science Foundation (\$25.0M) and the National Institutes of Health (\$20.8M). The single-largest private fund source was the Gordon & Betty Moore Foundation (\$4.7M).
- The top five campus units receiving awards were the UARC (\$25.2M), Institutes of Marine Sciences (\$15.0M), UCO/Lick (\$13.4M), Education (\$(9.6M), and Chemistry and Biochemistry (\$8.9M).
- Proposals submitted, 992, had a total value of \$300M.
